Summer Reading Assignments

Complete one of the three assignments below. This assignment is due during the first week of school.

Storyboard Scenes

Divide the novel into key scenes and create storyboards (comic strips) for those scenes. Each panel will capture a significant moment, along with dialogue or narrative. You must include at least six scenes.

Creative Writing

Do a creative writing activity inspired by the novel in one or two pages. You can write one of the following: an alternate ending, prequel, sequel, or spin-off of the book featuring the characters from the book.

Song Studio

Write a playlist of 6 songs representing the novel's theme, characters, and mood. Write 1 paragraph per song explaining how each represents the novel.
